## Mineworkings / Back Lanes Reinstatement / Nithsdale Road Clean-up Proposals

Phase 1 of the back lanes reinstatement had started with the vegetation and silt being removed and an assessment of the works required prior to relaying. No schedule was available for these works. It was approved that those involved with the works be invited to attend BITBL. The Marywood Square/ Queen Square back lane will not be included in the works. Nithsdale Road was to be power washed following the completion of the works.

#### **Bin Monitors**

The recent problem with bins being set alight was noted. A call would be made in the news letter for volunteers to assist in returning bins to their respective houses and monitoring persistent offenders.

## **Glasgow Civic Forum**
