The meeting was given an overview of the stalls attending this year's event including a promotional stall for the Society. It was asked that a call be put out on the blog for home baking and raffle prizes.

One costing we need for the event is security. Alison Hunter offered to source quotes for this and it was agreed that we would need to know if they also did first aid, crowd management and whether they could provide overnight security.

Allison Hussein said she is meeting with the council's events team to discuss costings for marquees and artificial grass.

BM said the draft application for grant funding would be completed by Sunday 23rd March. The deadline for costings is Friday 11th March.
