1. Minutes of 18 May 2021 meeting were approved. All matters arising are covered by the agenda below.	
2. <b>Treasurer's Report</b> . The grant application for £1,000 for Bungo (Not in the Back Lanes was approved by Pollokshields Area Partnership (PAP) – this includes £500 for staging the online marketplace and £50 for live music on the Saturday afternoon.  The annual accounts have been prepared and are with the independent examiner. They show a small deficit for the year.	0
3. Network Rail. Jane has circulated NR's most recent response, this time with reference to the footbridge consultation, including an explanation of their negative response to Option D (retention of existing bridge). The letter will be published on the blog.  There had been lots of enquiries to JC about moving the bridge location to Marywood Square.  The planned meeting with NR has still not been arranged although an extensive list of available times has been provided to them. Items for discussion include bridge design & positioning, also push back on their assertions (e.g. how do they know how many people use current bridge?).  KK had suggested advice be sought from Glasgow City Heritage Trus and making a case for a development grant (up to £10k), although it is very formal process. JC had followed up with initial application stating "investigating appropriate standards and aesthetics of a railway bridge a conservation area" which passed the first level criteria.
